On the road with Jördis: working student meets young energy transition talent

A central face of Ready. Charged. Career! is Jördis Flatterich, a working student at Energieküste. For the campaign, the 23-year-old from Immenstedt sets off in search of the latest training trends on the Energieküste, meets trainees and career changers in companies and talks to them about their goals and career paths. This is where Jördis meets Melissa Hanft, for example, who works at the energy transition company GP JOULE as an electronics technician for industrial



engineering. At the Elbe port in Brunsbüttel, the working student experiences port logistics at first hand and gets up close and personal with heavy equipment such as the 70-tonne dredger. She is accompanied by Lukas Kraft and Timo Timmermann, who have completed their training as port logistics specialists at the SCHRAMM group and have been taken on by their training company. In her latest training check, Jördis Flatterich takes a close look at Deutsche Windtechnik's lateral entry programme and talks to Jannik Josten and Achim Daries, who have made the leap from their former jobs as a bricklayer and carpenter to become service technicians for wind turbines.
